**Objectives**

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- Providing various tools and opportunities for data collection like surveys, polls, exit slips during parents’ meetings and orientation sessions.

- Teachers should maintain accurate records that describe students' performance in class and the use formative data to differentiate instruction

**Critical Initiatives**

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- Ensuring that all stakeholder groups have adequate and updated information concerning the school services, curricular and extracurricular programs.

- The revised curriculum should focus on conceptual learning, critical thinking and real-life experiences that enhance students’ problem-solving skills

- Using observation data, a needs assessment will be developed to identify the areas in which teachers need support. A professional development plan will be set for in-service training and PD days.

- Entry level exams and diagnostic assessments have been conducted to assess the academic level of the students during the first weeks of instruction

- Special orientation sessions should be conducted for students, parents or any other stakeholders’ groups that are involved in the use of the new technology resources.

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- Analyzing and using the data collected from stakeholders' groups in ways that inform the decision-making process

- Professional development plan should address the instructional and pedagogical requirements of the revised curriculum so as to create effective training opportunities for teachers

- The Leadership team, Heads of Department and Subject coordinators will receive training for eLoet observation tools and train other staff members.

- Intervention plans are set and extra time will be dedicated to support these students. Parents are continuously involved to provide support.
